The name of said corporation is Waterville Area Community Chest, Inc.

The purposes of said corporation are

(a) to promote the social welfare of the City of Waterville and the Towns of Winslow, Fairfield and Oakland by encouraging cooperation and community planning among the citizens of Waterville, Winslow, Fairfield and Oakland through its civic, educational, benevolent, charitable, character building and social-welfare agencies.

(b) to promote high standards, economy and efficiency in all social welfare agencies, individually and collectively, and to prevent waste and duplication of effort.

(c) to advise in the undertaking of any work by existing agencies and in the formation of new agencies.

(d) to promote the proper development of all public and private agencies dealing with social problems.

(e) to create and continue permanently a fund known as the Community Chest, which is to be collected cooperatively through voluntary subscriptions, as well as by gifts, bequests, and other means, which fund shall be periodically disbursed by the corporation, pursuant to its by-laws for the maintenance of separate member organizations.
